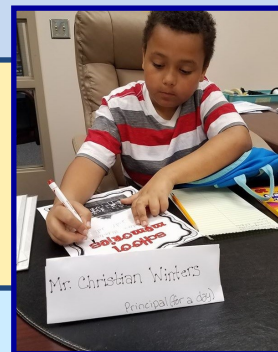
**COMMUNICATION**

## **Goal Language:**

Create a safe, positive learning environment that embraces diversity, social-emotional learning, and reflection that promotes continuous growth.

## **Action Steps:**

1. Cultivate previously established relationships with local safety officials, including the Elwood Police Department and the Elwood Fire Department.
2. Prioritize student and staff safety by ongoing analysis of and response to building facility needs.
3. Provide frequent and consistent instruction to students in the areas of safety, anti-bullying, self-advocacy, and conflict resolution.
4. Develop building-wide camaraderie and trust by analyzing culture and taking collective action toward an open, trusting, and positive learning/working environment for all.
