Treasurer's Report A lot was added to the budget. Things paid off were the Calendar Magnets, Meet & Greet, Back to School gifts, Pride Awards, Prizes & Awards, Stations/Reading Prized, PTO supplies, Room Parties, Staff Shirts, Movie License, Custodian Gifts. We were over budget by \$16.92 on the Back to School Gifts. Coke rewards needed us \$47.32. Our profit from Spirit Wear sales is \$126 adn the Cubs vs. Sox is \$250.71. We received 2 \$25 Staples gift cards from the school kits due to delivery issues and may add one of those to the 8th grade raffle basket and save the other for a teacher raffle. Our working balance is \$14,549.

Old Business

- **Soccer Nets** We received the soccer nets on October 9 and they are set up and ready for the students to enjoy. Playground equipment donations, \$668 from last years Penny Wars and Mrs. Midlock's donation of her retirement money gift was used to pay for these nets. The nets and frames cost \$1170.
- **Cubs vs. Sox Contest Update** Cubs won this fundraiser with a \$211.82 donation vs. \$38.89 for the Sox. This is a no cost fundraiser netting us \$250.71 which will be used for playground/recess equipment.
- **BoxTops Contest Update** Mrs. DeMaso's class earned an extra recess by winning the box tops contest with 255 tops. The total sent in by all classes earned \$124.60. Our total earnings for Box Tops from March of 2019 to November 1, 2019 is \$231.
- **Halloween Fun Fair** The Fun Fair was a bit different this year as it was held in the small gym, with 20 minute rotations between the gym and the classrooms. Kindergarteners and 1st graders, then 2nd & 3rd graders, and lastly 4th & 5th graders were together in the gym during their group times. Mrs. Peterson said she had positive feedback from the teachers. The 8th graders ran the stations which was much appreciated. They were given goody bags.

New Business

- **Family Movie Night & Raffle Baskets** Family Movie Night is December 13 from 6-8pm. This will be a free event for families but you must be with your child. We will be selling

popcorn and water. Cub Scouts will be selling tacos from 4:30 to 6 before the movie, but we are asking them to stop serving by 5:45 so people have time to finish eating before the movie starts. Raffle baskets will be on display and tickets will be sold before the movie starts. We will announce the raffle basket winners during an intermission of the movie, probably around 7pm. We plan on sending out an RSVP form so we will know if we are having the movie in the big gym or the small gym. We are leaning towards having it in the small gym since it is darker. The Student Council is donating their time to help with decorating and clean up. PTO will be selling Grinch Grams (a soft heart with a message) the week before the movie night for \$1 which is replacing the jingle grams sold in previous years. On Tuesday, 11/26, the raffle baskets will be set up in the IMC for a student preview where they will get their information and tickets to sell over the thanksgiving break.

- **Family Fun Night** Family Fun Night will be January 31, 2020 from 5-8pm in the big gym. It will cost \$10 per child. We will have bigger jumpies this year. We will be looking for sponsors. The company we get the jumpies from takes a cut of our ticket sales so we are not losing money if there's bad weather and fewer people show. We may not do mini golf this year and use the IMC for board games or other things instead.
- **Breakfast Club** Nurse Nawa brought to our attention last year that many students do not eat breakfast before they come to school. She is asking for ideas on how to get them to realize that breakfast is a very important meal. Possibly we can give a sticker or something if the kids write down what they've eaten. Mrs. Frey has talked about doing a fitness thing and we could tie those together. This is just in talks, no plans yet.
- **Christmas Room Parties** PreK room parties will be on 12/19 from 10-11 am for the am Pre-K, and 1:30-2:30 for the pm PreK. Kindergarten-5th grade parties will be on 12/20 from 12:10-1:10 pm. It is an early dismissal day. We need to figure out the snack for the parties. Lists have been sent to room parents. Mrs. Dearing asked if a reminder could be sent out closer to the date as well since she was the only parent who showed up in her room last year.
- **Announcement** This is the last year for the current PTO board. We will start looking for suitable replacements for next year which is why we are getting the word out now. We will run through the regular process of nominations in March and vote in April. Suitable candidates will need to understand working in a school environment requires trust, confidentiality and honesty, and the ability to show up and commit to doing things. Mrs. Peterson said "some people may be intimidated by the amount of things the PTO does so that can be scaled back." We can have fewer expectations and don't have to do everything the current board does. Mrs. Tallon asked if there has ever been a 3 member board? Mrs. Peterson was not sure but does remember a year when 1 member of the board basically did everything and ended up quitting ½ way through the year as it became too much. So we are definitely in need of 4 people who can work together as a

group. She also thanked us for all we do and have done for the students, teachers and school.
